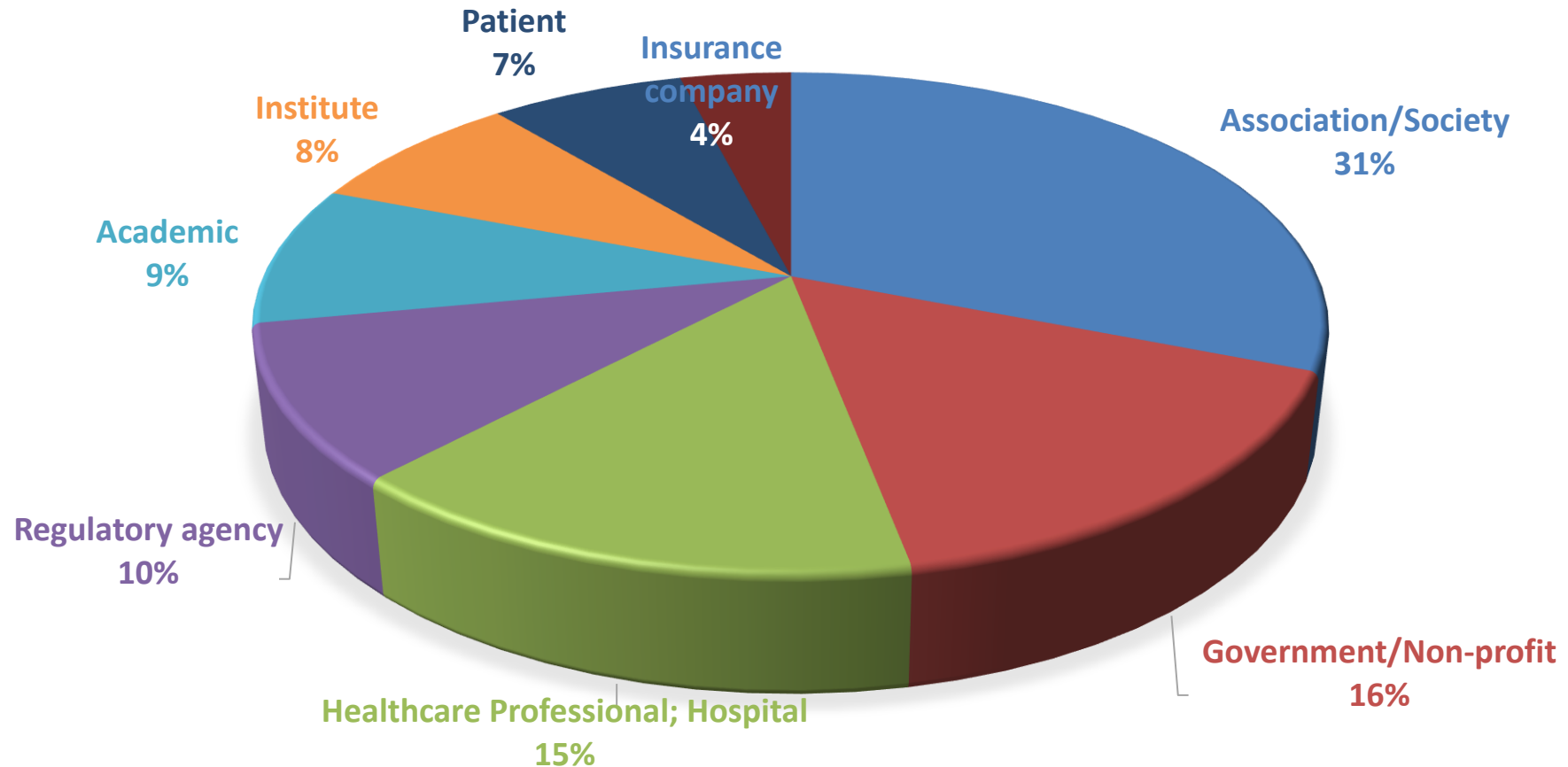

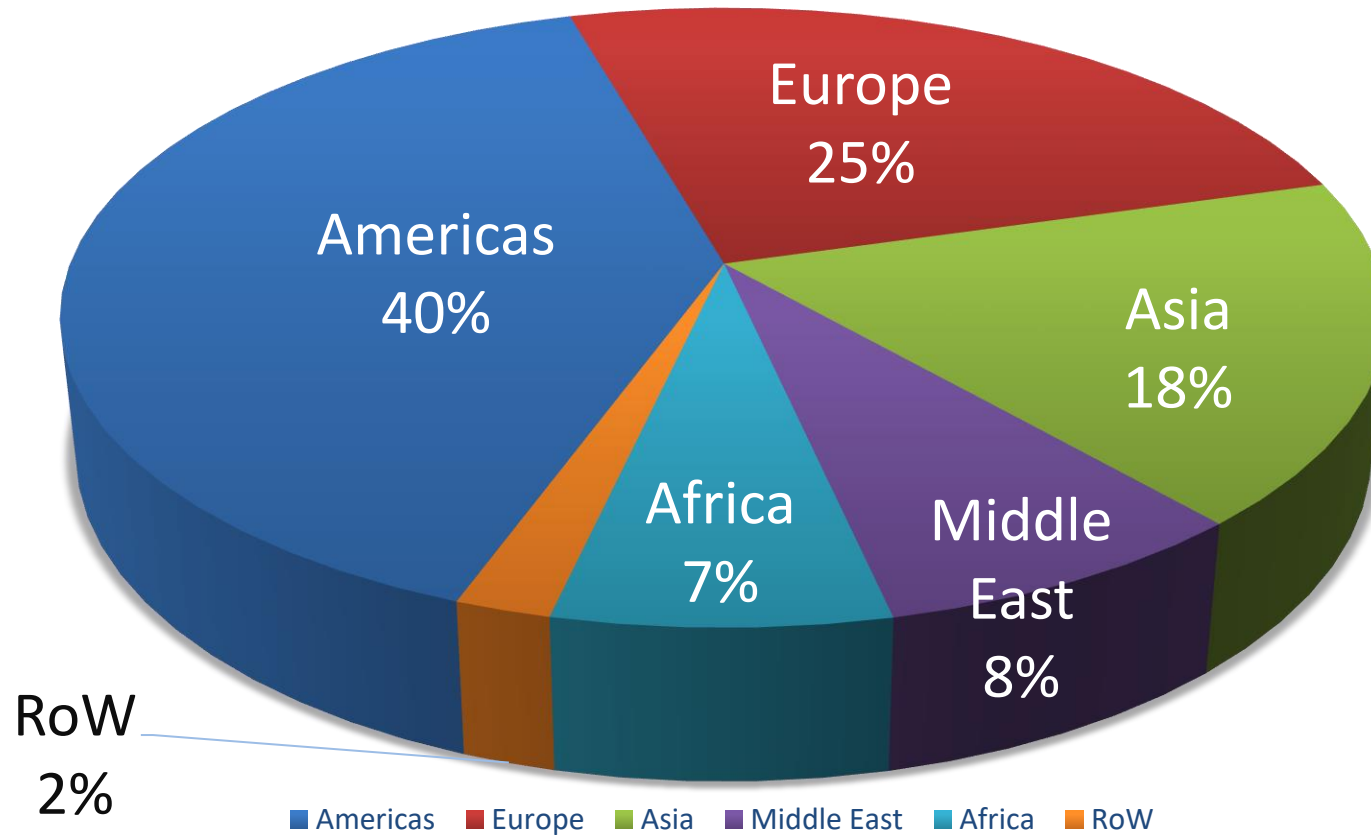
Group B (60%)
