

GaBi Journal – Guidance for Guest Authors

Generics and Biosimilars Initiative Journal (Official Journal of Generics and Biosimilars Initiative)

Thank you for accepting our invitation to contribute to *GaBi Journal* as a guest author. Please take a minute to read these guidelines, as it will facilitate the publication of your article and help to avoid unnecessary editing work.

The mission of *GaBi Journal* is to provide an independent, high quality, authoritative, and peer reviewed platform for the publication of scientific articles concerning any aspect of the research into and development of cost-effective medicines, irrespective of their source. This Open Access journal will thus make information on pharmaceutical innovation and developments in generic and biosimilar medicines accessible to everyone, including physicians, pharmacists and nurses; patients/consumers, drug developers, third-party payers, legislators and assessors, for use in all aspects of their clinical, scientific and professional work.

It is important that your article is the correct length when submitted. The length of one page, including references and abstract with one picture or table, should be approximately 6,000 characters with spaces; for two pages 12,000 characters with spaces. The article title should have a maximum of 12 words. Authors' by-line should consist of a maximum of three authors, with all additional authors listed at the end of the article. Please limit addresses to one per author.

Please start your article with a short abstract or summary of maximum 160 characters with spaces for 1-page articles, 250 characters with spaces for articles of two pages or more. The article should be shortened accordingly if you choose to include more than one diagram, table or picture. Single-page articles should have no more than eight references, while 2- to 3-page articles may have up to 15 references (Vancouver style). You are welcome to provide suitable graphics which should be in high quality jpg formats (over 150 KB). Finally, please include your contact/postal address (one only), email and/or telephone number for publication with your article.

The guest author is recognised to be an authority on the subject of the article, and by inviting distinguished authors we ensure that a high standard of information is presented to our readers.

Although you are solely responsible for the accuracy of the information in the article, we may nevertheless have to make some editorial changes for a variety of reasons. For example, we are pleased to help with the English, if this is not your native language. Unfortunately, we sometimes find ourselves compelled to make unexpected changes in the length of an article, or to postpone publication to a following issue. Therefore, it is only possible to give you an estimate of the actual publication issue. You will be sent a copy of your article (if any changes are made) for approval before publication and a complimentary copy of the journal issue after publication.
